

General Rules and Regulations

- 1. Only current 4-H and FFA members who reside in South Carolina, Georgia, and North Carolina will be able to participate in the shows. Non-members will not be allowed to participate in the shows.
- Purebred cattle must be registered with their National Breed Association. Registration papers must be in the name of the exhibitor. Cattle not registered will be entered in the crossbred classes.
- 3. Exhibitors must have owned all animals at least 30 days prior to the date of the show.
- 4. Exhibitors must provide adequate food and water for their animal exhibits and always keep their animals and area clean and presentable.
- Animals will be released after the completion of each show. There will be no removal of animals while the shows are in progress. Any exhibitor removing animals without official release or before release time forfeits all prize monies or awards.
- 6. No bulls or bucks are allowed at the Laurens County Youth Livestock Shows.
- 7. The show superintendent and his designees will rule on all matters not covered by these or other department rules.
- Any exhibitor using abusive or excessive force with their animal as determined by the on-site show superintendent or his designees will be asked to leave the premises and forfeit any premium money.
- Entry forms and entry fees must be IN HAND at the Laurens County Extension Office by August 11th, 2023. Late entries will receive a \$15 late fee. NO entries will be accepted after August 18th, 2023. All requested information must be completed for an entry for an entry form to be considered official. Entry fees are \$5 per entry per class. Money orders and/or checks are accepted

and should be written to Laurens County

Cattleman's Association (LCCA). Entries will be received until the entry deadline or until entries exceed the capacity as determined by the show superintendent. Mail entries to Laurens County Extension, 219 W Laurens Street, Laurens, SC 29360

- 10. Online Registration is available. All requested information must be completed for an entry to be considered official. Late registration is NOT available online.
- 11. Exhibitors must show their own animal in the **showmanship** classes.
- 12. Show staff reserves the right to combine and break classes as needed based on the number of entries per class. Classes with less than four entries it may be combined with another class. Shows deemed to not have enough entries will be cancelled.
- NO STALLING AREA WILL BE PROVIDED. All animals should be safely tied to their trailers. Wash areas will be provided. If you have questions about our set up, please feel free to call us at 864-705-1102.
- 14. Any animal coming from outside of South Carolina must have a health certificate.
- 15. It is strongly encouraged that all cattle be vaccinated for respiratory diseases (shipping fever), specifically, IBR, P13, BRSV, and Pasteurella not more than 6 months and not less than 2 weeks prior to the show.
- 16. All animals should be healthy and free of any signs of infectious, contagious, or communicable diseases. The show superintendent and designees are appointed by him have the authority to dismiss any animal viewed as unhealthy from the premises.

- 3. All exhibitors are responsible for providing their own holding pen for their dog while the dogs are not being shown.
- All breed classes will be shown with all breeds combined. Ages are determined by youth's age on Jan 1, 2023.

Rules and Regulations

- 1. All entries shall be subject to the General Rules and Regulations of the Laurens County Youth Show.
- Beef Cattle entry fees are \$5 per entry per class. The entry fees and forms must be IN HAND at the Laurens County Extension Office by Friday, August 11th, 2023. Mail entries to: Laurens County Extension, 219 W Laurens Street, Laurens, SC 29360. Make checks payable to Laurens County Cattleman's Association.
- Beef Cattle will be received between 3:30PM 4:30PM on Friday, August 25th. All cattle must be in place by 4:30PM – NO EXCEPTIONS!
- The Beef Show is open to the following breeds: British Breeds (Angus, Poled Hereford, Shorthorn), Continental Breeds (Simmental, Limousin, Charolais, Gelvieh, Salers, Main Anjou, etc.), and Crossbreeds (crossbred cattle and registered Zebu influenced breeds).
- 5. Showmanship ages are determined as of Jan 1, 2023.
- 6. Heifers and steers are eligible for showmanship classes.
- 7. Feeders steer weight range is 450 1,000 lbs. Steers not in this weight range are not eligible.
- Feeder steers will be weighed prior to the show. Classes will be determined based on this weight as calculated by the beef show superintendent. The number of steer show classes will be influenced by steer weights and the number of steers competing. A maximum of three classes will be conducted.

- All entries shall be subject to the General Rules and Regulations of the Laurens Youth Show. All decisions made by the show superintendent, or his designee(s) are considered final.
- Rabbit entry fees are \$5 per entry per class. The entry fees and forms must be IN HAND at the Laurens County Extension Office by August 11th, 2023. Mail entries to: Laurens County Extension, 219 W. Laurens Street, Laurens, SC 29360. Make checks payable to Laurens County Cattleman's Association (LCCA).
- All exhibitors are responsible for providing their own holding pens for rabbits while rabbits are not being shown.
- 4. We ask that no rabbits be placed in the grass while on the premises.
- 5. Showmanship classes will be shown with all
- 6. breeds combined. Showmanship ages are determined by age on Jan 1, 2023.
- 7. All animals must be checked in and ready to show by 6:00PM -- NO EXCEPTION!
- 8. Please note that all rabbits should have tattoos. There will be an opportunity to have your rabbits tattooed the day of the show.

- All entries shall be subject to the General Rules and Regulations of the Laurens County Youth Show.
- Dairy Cattle entry fees are \$5 per entry per class. The entry forms and fees must be IN HAND at the Laurens County Extension Office by Friday, August 11th. Mail entries to: Laurens County Extension, 219 W Laurens Street, Laurens, SC 29360. Make checks payable to Laurens County Cattleman's Association.
- Dairy Cattle will be received between 7 8 am on Saturday, August 26th. All cattle must be in place by 8 am -- NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 4. The Dairy Show is open to registered Holstein, Jersey, Guernsey, and Brown Swiss heifers.
- 5. Conformation classes will be divided by breeds.
- Showmanship ages are determined as of Jan 1, 2023.
- The Laurens County Youth Dairy Show is open to any 4-H, FFA, or Dairy Breed Association Youth members residing in South Carolina, Georgia, or North Carolina.
- The Wesley Robinson Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to the winner of the Senior Showmanship class. Winner must be a South Carolina resident to receive the scholarship.

Rules and Regulations

- 1. All entries shall be subject to the General Rules and Regulations of the Laurens County Youth Show.
- The Meat Goat Classes are only open to 4-H or FFA members residing in South Carolina, Georgia, and North Carolina.
- Youth Meat Goat Show entry fees are \$5 per entry per class. Entries in Class 710 are \$15 per entry. The entry fees and forms must be IN HAND at the Laurens County Extension Office by Friday, August 11th. Mail entries to: Laurens County Extension, 219 W Laurens Street, Laurens, SC 29360. Make checks payable to Laurens County Cattleman's Association.
- Animals will be received between 11am 12pm on Saturday, August 26th. All goats must be in place by 12 pm – NO EXCEPTIONS! Scales will close 30 minutes prior to the start of the show.
- 5. Exhibitors must furnish their own feed and water for their animals.
- Exhibitors may show any goat in showmanship that they have entered in the SC4ME Wethers (born and bred), Open SC Meat Goat Project Wethers, Open Wethers, or Market Doe Classes.
- 7. Showmanship ages are based on participant's age as of Jan 1, 2023.
- 8. **SC4ME (Born and Bred):** All SC4ME wethers must be tagged with an SC4ME tag and registered to the exhibitor through the SC Meat Goat Project. The number of SC4ME Market Wether classes will be determined by the wether weight on the day of show and is at the discretion at the show staff. All decisions are final. Only open to SC 4-H/FFA Meat Goat Project participants.
- 9. Open SC Goat Project Market Wethers: All SC Meat Goat Project open wethers will be show in this class. The number of SC Meat Goat Project open wether classes will be determined by weights on the day of the show and is at the discretion of the show staff. All decisions are final.
- 10. **Open Market Wethers:** Any Georgia or North Carolina exhibitors will be entered in this market wether class only. South Carolina 4-H/FFA members who are not part of the SC Meat Goat Project and project participants registering non-project wethers, will be entered in this class. Only wethers that are registered on the entry form and class fee received by postmark date can be weighed in at the show. If an exhibitor has more than one wether in a weight class, it is up to the exhibitor to

find a fellow youth showman to exhibit the wether. The number of Open Market Wether classes will be determined by weights on the day of the show and is at the discretion of the show staff. All decisions are final.

- 11. **Market Does:** Market Does must be born between September 1, 2022 and June 10, 2023. Each exhibitor can weigh in up to 6 does. Only does that are registered on the entry form and class fee received by postmark date can be weighed in at the show. If an exhibitor has more than one doe in a weight class, it is up to the exhibitor to find a fellow youth showman to exhibit the doe. The number of Market Doe Classes will be determined by doe weight at the show and is at the discretion of the show staff. All decisions are final.
- 12. Exhibitors must be able to control their animal(s) at all times during the show. Parents are not allowed in the show ring to assist their child during judging. Parents entering the ring during judging to assist their own child will result in the exhibitor being disqualified.
- 13. Cloverbud exhibitors may request a senior exhibitor to accompany them in the SC4ME, Open Wether, and Market Doe classes ONLY. NO assistant will be allowed in showmanship classes. The assistant is only allowed to step in and control the goat for the safety of the exhibitor(s) or the goat. Assistants are not allowed to lead, set-up, or brace the goats. Show staff must be made aware if a Cloverbud will be having an assistant prior to the start of the show.
